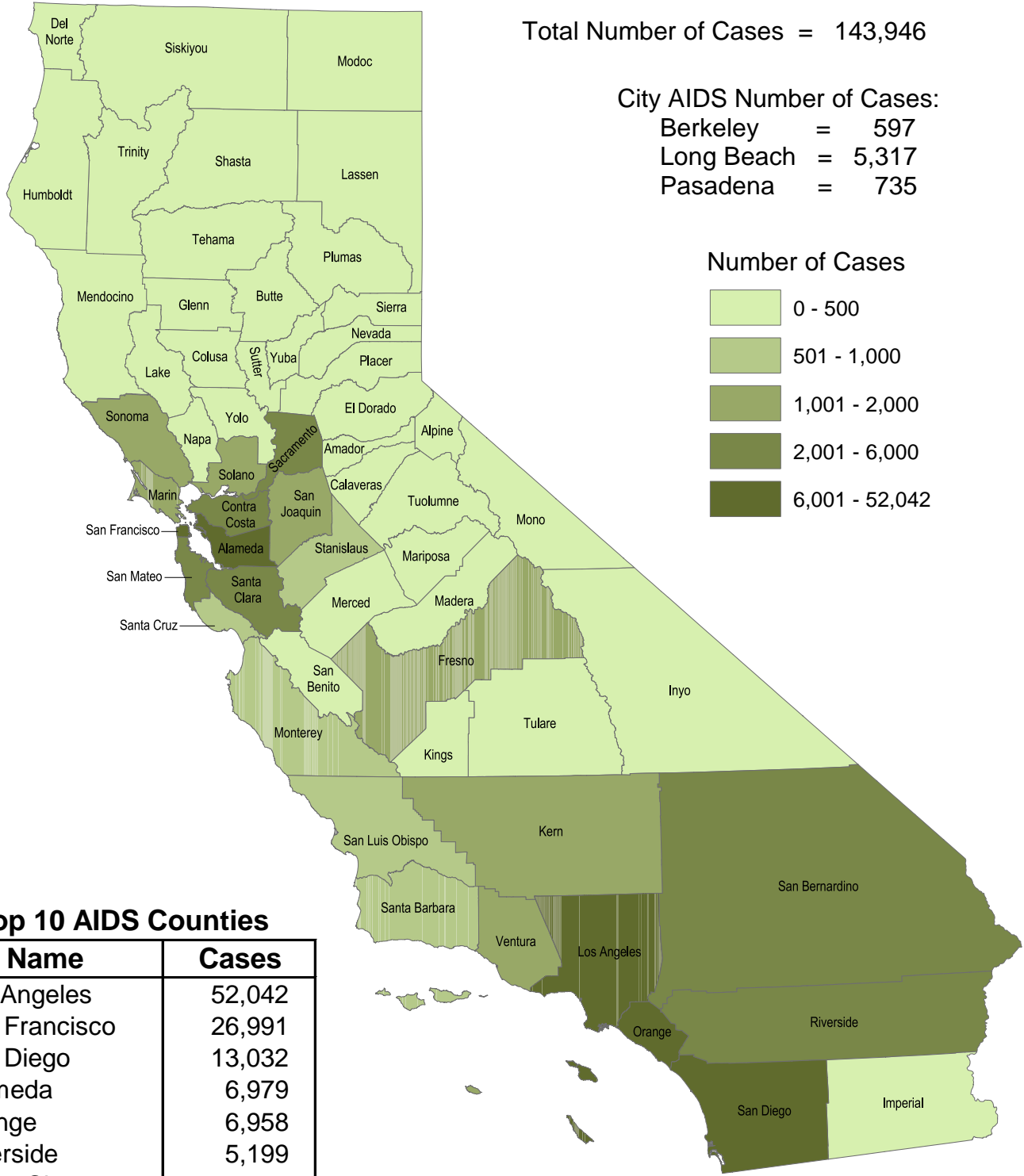


# AIDS CASES IN CALIFORNIA CUMULATIVE AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2006

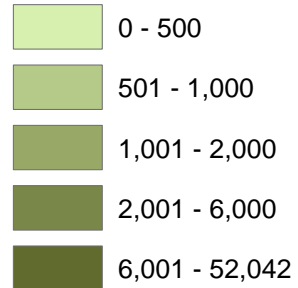
